The Bovine Breed of Kea

During the years "AMALTHIA" has been engaged in more than 20 projects for which "We" are proud of.



One of the most important projects is the "rediscovery" of a recognised bovine breed thought to be extinct more than 4 decades ago.

The KEA is the only milk producing Greek breed and was used also for agricultural activities.

A herd of 21 was discovered on the remote island of Makronisos in 2012.

Today, "Amalthia" has established 2 breeding groups on the island of Kea. The search continues in other parts of Greece for other Kea animals.

Funding is the biggest obstacle that "We" face in order to achieve our goals, especially during the current recession.

Legislation & bureaucracy consists a major obstacle, since it favors modern breeds and does not allow changes.
