About SZH, rare breeds and €

Little bit of history:

- Until 2008: premiums for owners of rare breeds
- 2008-2010: premiums stopped, subsidy system didn't work, €200.000 for SZH to support breeding organisations.
- From 2013: € 80.000 for SZH. Every 5 years evaluation.

Common Agricultural Policy (CAP/GLB) 2023-2026: €
200.000 for SZH <u>and</u> €3 million of premiums for the
farmers/breeders!

How did we do it

- Upcoming sustainable farming
- Chances for the rare breeds in the agro ecological farming systems
- Paraplubestand made premiums workable again
- Evaluation confirmed the unique role of SZH



Coorperation

Ministry: lobby activities became support activities

Platforms: cattle, sheep and goat, small livestock (poultry/rabbits), small producers.

SZH approved locations (for breeding, for education and for products)







SZH Goals 2023-2026

- 1. Find biggest challenges of breeding organisations
- 2. Support breeding organisations
- 3. Look for chances to stimulate sustainable use of genetic recourses, also with suitable regulation.
- 4. Protect the rare breeds from extinction, for example in case of diseases.
- 5. Get more knowledge on rare breeds by research, exchange knowledge by giving the stage to farmers.
- 6. Find ways to promote the rare breeds at potential new breeders
